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NON-IMMIGRANT VISA REQUIREMENTS

A. PLEASURE OR BUSINESS VISA

1. Duly accomplished non-immigrant visa application form (F.A. Form 2-A). All entries in the application form should be completed. Entries that are not applicable should be marked as N/A. Incomplete forms shall not be processed and will be returned to the applicant. Minors/children should submit a separate visa application form, which may be accomplished by a parent on their behalf:
2. A valid passport. The validity of the passport must be at least six (6) months beyond the length of the intended stay in the Philippines:
3. One (1) 2" x 2" size photograph taken within the last six (6) months, with the applicant's signature at the front side portion:
4. Two (2) photocopies of return airline ticket and/or confirmed booking from travel agency:
5. Proof of Financial Capacity:
 - Pleasure: Photocopy of any one of the following (a) latest Bank Statement (b) previous year's Income Tax Return or most recent Pay Stub, or an Employment Certificate from employer indicating position and salary.
 - Business: Letter from employer and/or sponsor of the trip indicating the specific purpose or nature of the trip, length of stay (inclusive dates), company/ies to be visited, and a guarantee of all moral and financial obligations incurred by the person while in the Philippines.
6. If applicant is not appearing in person before the Honorary Consular Officer, the duly accomplished application form must be notarized by a Notary Public or by any New Zealand official authorized to administer statutory oaths.
7. All mailed application must be accompanied by a pre-paid courier bag.

B. VISA FOR MINOR

1. Children under fifteen (15) years old who are national of any country, except the Philippines, are permitted entry as long as they are accompanied by one or both parents during their travel to the Philippines. Special entry requirements apply to foreign minors under 15 years old who will travel unaccompanied by their parents. The parent (s) of minor-applicants are advised to contact the Honorary Consulate General for information on guidelines and procedures to be followed under this category.

C. VISA FEES

- a. Holder of New Zealand Passport: An applicant who holds a New Zealand passport is exempted from payment of a visa fee when applying for a single entry visa with a validity of three (3) months, pursuant to a visa fee waiver agreement between the Philippines and New Zealand. **The maximum period of stay granted by the Embassy under this category is 59 days.**

This initial period may be extended once the visa holder is already in the Philippines. An application for extension should be filed directly with the Philippine Bureau of Immigration in Manila or with the local immigration office closest to where the applicant is temporarily residing. Appropriate fees will be collected by the Immigration office for this application.

An applicant wishing to enter the Philippines more than once during the year may apply for a multiple-entry visa with the Embassy. The appropriate fees are as follows:

- Multiple entry visa with validity of six (6) months NZ\$ 84.00
- Multiple entry visa with validity of twelve (12) months NZ\$ 126.00

- b. Holder of a Fiji or Samoa Passport: A fee of NZ\$ 42.00 will be collected from an applicant from the Republic of the Fiji Islands or Samoa for a single-entry visa (valid for three months); or NZ\$ 84.00 for a multiple entry visa valid for six (6) months; or NZ\$ 126.00 for a multiple entry visa valid for twelve (12) months.
- c. Other Nationalities: Unless an applicant is a national of a country with which the Philippines has an existing visa fee waiver agreement, the schedule of fees in item (b) above applies. Applicants are advised to inquire with the Honorary Consulate General on visa fees applicable to their nationality.

IMPORTANT:

- Except for certain nationalities, a foreign passport holder travelling to the Philippines for tourism or business purposes and staying thereat for NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-ONE (21) days may enter the Philippines without and entry visa provided he/she is able to present a valid passport and an outbound or return ticket to immigration officials upon arrival in the Philippines. An applicant may verify with the Honorary Consulate General whether he/she is entitled to this privilege.
- All applications for non-immigrant visa must be submitted at least three to four (3-4) weeks before the scheduled departure of the applicant. Processing takes three to five (3-5) working days upon receipt of application.
- The Honorary Consular Officer may require an applicant to submit additional requirements or supporting documents other than those listed above, as may be necessary to determine eligibility to hold a visa.
